Curricular and Extracurricular Student Attendance Project

What it is

At the Data Collection Committee meeting in February 2018, it was noted that school and district presence/absence reporting varies throughout the state on student time spent travelling to/from sports and extracurricular activities. For this reason, we're doing a project to attempt to determine:

- 1. Whether students missing in-class time for curricular and extracurricular activities is affecting chronic absenteeism rates.
- 2. If students that miss time for curricular and extracurricular activities have different outcomes (dropout/graduation) from students that do not miss time for curricular and extracurricular activities.
- 3. If the type of absences (curricular/extracurricular/band/choir) matter in the outcome of students.
