

The Healthy Homes Grant Program (HHGP) is excited to share that the first Request for Grant Application (RFGA) – **Round 1 Competitive Funding** - will be announced soon. The program anticipates that the RFGA will open in January with an anticipated deadline in March. Keep an eye out for more detailed information - coming soon - on the <u>HHGP</u> <u>website</u>.

Round 1 Competitive Funding will include:

- \$8.5 million total dollars
- Small track (approximately 15 between \$25,000-200,000)
- Large track (approximately 15 between \$200,001-750,000)
- 3-year funding cycle
- Eligible entities are listed on the <u>HHGP website</u>
- Priority consideration will be given to:
 - Organizations experienced in maximizing energy efficiency, extending the usable life of homes, or improving the health or safety of occupants of residences, which serves eligible households in Oregon.
 - Proposals demonstrating evidence-based activities which are intended to improve the health and safety of residents.
 - Organizations serving historically unrepresented and underserved communities including People of color, low-income, and American Indian/Alaska Native communities.

* Note: \$1.5 million has been set aside for non-competitive funding for Federally Recognized Tribes in Oregon.
