TO CHARGE A SCREENING FEE THE LANDLORD MUST:









## **PROVIDE**

**Promptly provide** a copy and confirmation of the receipt of anu screening/credit report.



## SHARE the approximate





Units available or will be availble in a reasonable time.

**APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED** AND UNDER CONSIDERATION

This number should reflect units of the same type and in the same area that the applicant is applying for.

- The Cost of Screening
- Screening process and criteria
- The applicant's right to dispute Screening or credit report findings.
- The landlord's non-discrimination policy, if they have one, and current federal, state and local nondiscrimination rules, policies and statutes.
- · The Rent and Deposit amount. (subject to change by agreement)
- If renter's INSURANCE is required and the amount needed to comply.
- The applicant's right to a REFUND of screening fee within 30 days IF:
  - 1.) It was Not completed AND
  - 2.) Applicant requests IN WRITTING

Plus the cost of screening

The amount an applicant may recover from landlord if they do not comply with any of the above.
