Be an active team

player...talk with your KWC health team about health questions, health challenges, and any other health care professionals who are caring for you.

Your Role As a Patient

- Communicate closely with KWC.
- Keep KWC current with your medications, immunizations, allergies, conditions, tests, consultations, hospitalizations.
- Advise KWC of any changes in your medical history.
- Inform and authorize other providers to coordinate with us.
- Participate with your team to make decisions about your health.
- Follow treatment plans and manage your self-care.
- Speak up and ask questions!

Step 1 - Check Eligibility

KWC-Eugene is open to all Native Americans and Alaska Natives and community members with insurance plans that we accept. All NA/AN must have proof of Tribal Identity

If you are uninsured, you may qualify for the Oregon Health Plan (OHP), the State's plan that providers coverage for Oregonians from all walks of life. This includes, American Indian and Alaska Natives, working families, children, pregnant women, single adults, and seniors. Primary Care Clinic
