Paying for college

Often financial planning for college starts with filling out the FAFSA for federal student aid. Payment plans and budget resources can help you manage your tuition and expenses.

- FAFSA: Apply each year for federal student aid and work-study job opportunities. Lane's Federal School Code is 003196.
- OSAC: Oregon Scholarship Application for state residents. Opens early November with a deadline of April 1.
- Lane Foundation Scholarships: Available for all LCC students. Application opens in early January with a deadline of March 1. More than \$1,000,000 in scholarships to new and returning students each year.
- Oregon Promise Grant: Covers most tuition costs for recent GED completers/high school graduates planning to attend an Oregon community college.
- ORSAA: For undocumented students in Oregon, including DACA status.
