



KEEP is a statewide support program available to Oregon's resource, kinship, adoptive, and assisted guardian parents raising youth ages 2 and up

- Explore and share parenting strategies with support from your peers
- A 16-week group facilitated by trained group leaders
- Available in English, Spanish, ASL, and online
- KEEP is trauma-informed
- Participants can earn up to 24 training hours
- Receive \$25/household for each session attended (up to \$400)
- We will find a group that works for your schedule
