## WORKING WITH YOUR FINANCES

Explore options like federal and state grants, scholarships, and work-study programs to help cover your costs.

- FAFSA: Federal student aid. Apply each year using LCC's code 003196.
- ORSAA: For undocumented students in Oregon, including DACA status.
- OSAC: Oregon Scholarship for state residents. Opens early November and closes April 1.
- Foundation Scholarships: application opens in early January and closes March 1.
- Oregon Promise Grant: Covers most tuition costs for recent GED completers/high school graduates to attend an Oregon community college.
