About the Training

This training provides an overview of concepts and practices fundamental to nicotine and tobacco treatment. This includes a review of addiction and the brain, a look into a bio-psychosocial perspective of tobacco dependence, an overview of pharmacotherapy options, discussion on screening and assessment, exploration of communication strategies, review of the readiness for change model, identification of diversity considerations, and coverage of basic treatment strategies. The training includes multiple interactive components including group discussion, small group break-outs, self-assessment, skills practice, and more.
