Attending NW Cyber Camp helps you discover if cybersecurity is a career field you should explore more.

No prior experience is required to attend this free program

NW Cyber Camp offers day camps, not overnight programs

Spend a week with UO professors at NW Cyber Camp learning core cybersecurity concepts including confidentiality, integrity, availability (C-I-A), how to think like an adversary, and ethics.

Apply these concepts as part of a team to solve a cybersecurity workplace scenario. Teams will be confronted with a simulated network and computer attack in progress. Then teams will use various techniques and tools to find, trace, diagnose, and stop adversaries before they can implant ransomware and exfiltrate then encrypt valuable data.

Will you be able to stop the attack?
