Services for participating individuals may include the following:

- ✓ **Career Advancement** - such as exploring your skills and strengths, getting your GED, help keeping your current job, short-term training, job leads, supported work experience
 - ✓ **Building Job Search Skills** - such as help with applications, resume writing, interview practice and networking
 - ✓ **Home and Family** - such as community resources, childcare options, navigation services (for example, affordable housing and counseling), and budgeting.
 - ✓ **Support Services**- such as potential work-related transportation, tools, interview clothing
