Holiday Food Boxes and Tree of Joy are limited to the Cottage Grove, Creswell and surrounding communities. Three types of boxes will be available: Traditional, Latin and No-Cook. Someone else can pick up your boxes and gifts – tell Community Sharing at time of application or call to advise.

Please note: Proof of income will be needed! ODHS verification of benefits can be used as proof. A self-attestation paper can be provided to those with no income. Income requirements are 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.

The registration period for the 2025 Campaign opens **October 1st, 2025** and will close **November 15th, 2025**. Please be sure to register as soon as possible, as we are unable to accept late registrations and walk-ins. **All recipients must be registered online.**

Requirements (No photocopies, original documents only):

- Proof of Lane County residency, that the child lives with you, and of child's age

It is strongly suggested not to bring children to pick up. **Please bring required documents on Distribution Day.**

Example of Required Documents

- For Parents/Guardians:
 - Local Photo ID with address (this provides proof of residency in Lane County)
- For Children: Any number
 - Birth Certificate
 - Recent School Report Cards
 - IRS Tax Forms
 - Medical Documents Showing Both Parents and child's names
 - DHS Paperwork if it includes a child's age
 - Renter's agreement
 - Any other legal documentation that includes both the parent's and child's name(s) and date of birth(s)

Families will be notified after registration of their pick-up location, dates and times.

Distribution Start Date: 12/01/2025

First date of toy distribution. Approved applicants will be notified of specific distribution dates and locations. Check website for additional distribution details.

Distribution End Date: 12/15/2025

Date when all toy distributions are expected to be completed.
