Services for participating individuals may include the following:

- ✓ **Career Advancement** - exploring skills and strengths, getting a GED, help keeping a current job, short-term training, job leads, supported work experience.
- ✓ **Job Search Skills** - help with applications, resume writing, interview practice and networking.
- ✓ **Home and Family** - explore community resources, childcare options, navigation services (ie. affordable housing and counseling), and budgeting.
- ✓ **Support Services**- potential work-related transportation, tools, interview clothing
