

## Support for the Indoor Clean Air Act (ICAA) and increasing protection against secondhand exposure (among Oregon adults)

Support for ICAA	
Oregon's Indoor Clean Air Act prohibits smoking and vaping tobacco, nicotine, or marijuana inside public places and inside workplaces. Smoking or vaping within 10 feet of building entrances is also prohibited.	
Do you support the ICAA?	86% strongly or somewhat support the ICAA <sup>(1)</sup>

Do you support or oppose expanding Oregon's law beyond 10 feet?	64% strongly or somewhat support <sup>(2)</sup>
Do you support or oppose making <u>outdoor seating areas</u> at restaurants, bars, brewpubs, etc. smoke- and vape-free?	70% strongly or somewhat support <sup>(1)</sup>
Do you support or oppose a law to make all hotels and motels <u>entirely</u> smoke- and vape-free?	64% strongly or somewhat support <sup>(1)</sup>
