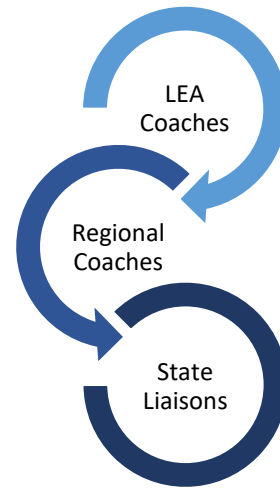


Opportunity to Apply for State Personnel Development Grant

Purpose

The State Personnel Development Grant provides funds to districts to support implementation of evidence-based practices within a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS), the Oregon Integrated Systems (ORIS) Framework. Selected districts receive funds to support implementation of the framework, utilizing a district-identified coach that works with up to four schools.

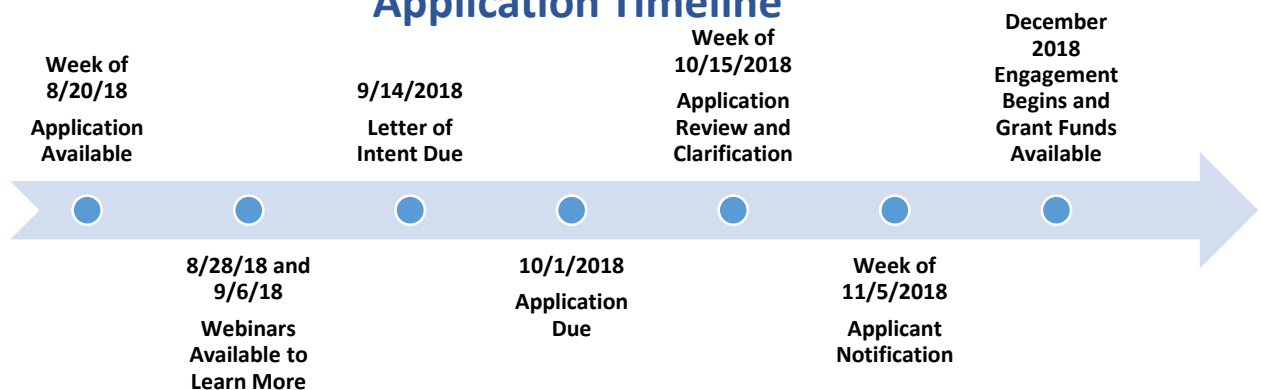
Funds support district coaching activities related to implementing a multi-tiered system of supports (ORIS)

- Grant funding (.2FTE) through 2021
- High-quality professional learning for coaches
- LEA coaches will be supported by ESDs through partnership with a regional MTSS coach
- State liaisons provide technical assistance and supports
- Grant activities aligned to Oregon's district and school continuous improvement process

Eligible Participants

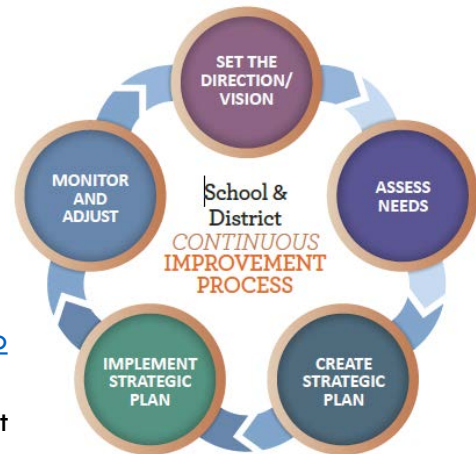
- Districts seeking to implement or refine evidence-based practices within a multi-tiered system of support
- Districts committed to supporting implementation/instructional coaching at elementary or middle schools

State Personnel Development Grant at a Glance

- ✓ ODE supports a **partnership with districts** in order to establish and sustain a multi-tiered system of support, the ORIS Framework
- ✓ Districts use funds to **support implementation activities** such as coaching, travel to professional development, release time for building staff
- ✓ Ongoing coach professional learning opportunities position ODE's **continuous improvement process** as the roadmap for district and school activities. See [ODE's revamped approach to the continuous improvement process](#).
- ✓ Regional coaches and state-supported liaisons actively support **alignment of multiple initiatives** within districts and schools through two-way communication with LEA coaches

1. Watch the webinar
