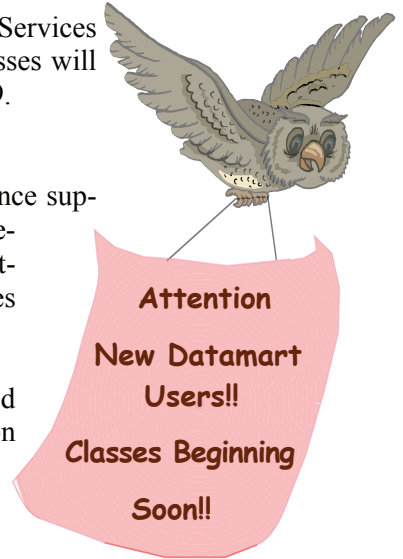
## Hyperion Training Coming Soon!

The Datamart Team and HRSD (Human Resources Services Division) are pleased to announce that Hyperion classes will resume on a limited basis beginning in February 2009.

As reported in the last edition of the *Datamart Connection*, HRSD has lost use of the facility that once supported their computer-based classes, such as Hyperion. The new training facility, located at the Department of Veteran's Affairs won't be ready for classes until possibly May.

To bridge the gap, HRSD will be offering modified versions of the Hyperion Introduction and Hyperion Reporting classes from February through April.

## Report Repository Update

The Report Repository on Hyperion provides an efficient way of managing and distributing standardized queries that can be accessed by all Datamart users.

The repository works especially well for queries common to all agencies, such as the Trial Balance query, which separates debit balances from credit balances. There's no need for agency personnel to create their own query when all they have to do

is specify the limits applicable to them and run the repository query!

Currently, there are 30 queries on the Repository, covering a variety of areas. The list includes several payroll, accounting, and budget queries such as one for calculating military leave without pay, a Budget vs. Expenditure query for balancing to the 61 screen, and several DAFR queries to assist with period 13 activities.

Several Datamart users have expressed an interest in gathering as a group to provide a framework for the Repository.

The group will determine the best way to manage the contents of the Repository, establish standards for Dashboard design, query definitions naming conventions, etc. The group will meet for the first time in March. If anyone else is interested please contact Linda Flicker.

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# Training
