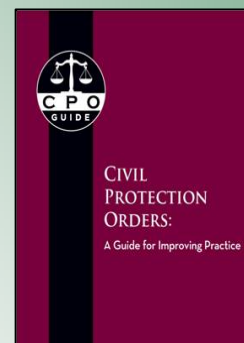


What's my Job; What's your Job?
