4. Event Summary:**Summary**

The National Weather Service is forecasting severe weather starting January 8 and continuing through at least January 13. The forecasted severe weather will have statewide impacts and includes blizzard conditions in the mountains above 3,000 feet; high surf and coastal flooding due to the active weather patterns along with high astronomical tides; and potentially lowland snow.

The forecasted weather may cause treacherous travel conditions and road closures, power outages, and need for temporary warming shelters.

6. Current and Planned Objectives:**Objectives**

- Coordinate the dissemination of situational awareness information to tribal, state, local and federal partners, and other stakeholders.
- Communicate and coordinate with tribal, local, statewide, and federal partners to identify emergent resource and capability gaps.
- Identify resources available to fulfill potential resource requests.
- Provide technical assistance and subject matter expertise to empower tribal and local jurisdictions to respond to needs in their communities and recover from emergent impacts.

7. Planned Activities:

- ECC Planning Coordination Section Chief will:
 - Gather situational awareness updates from responding ESFs about weather-related impacts, actions being performed, and information about any potential resource needs or shortfalls.
 - Consolidate situational awareness information from regional support staff and responding ESFs into an ECC situational awareness email briefing.
 - Distribute daily ECC situational awareness email briefings.
- Regional Support Staff will:
 - Participate in regional planning and coordination meetings to provide technical assistance to tribal and jurisdictional emergency managers to prepare for or respond to emergent impacts.
 - Gather situational awareness updates from tribal or jurisdictional emergency managers about weather-related impacts, actions being performed, and information about any potential resource needs or shortfalls and share with the ECC Planning Coordination Section Chief.

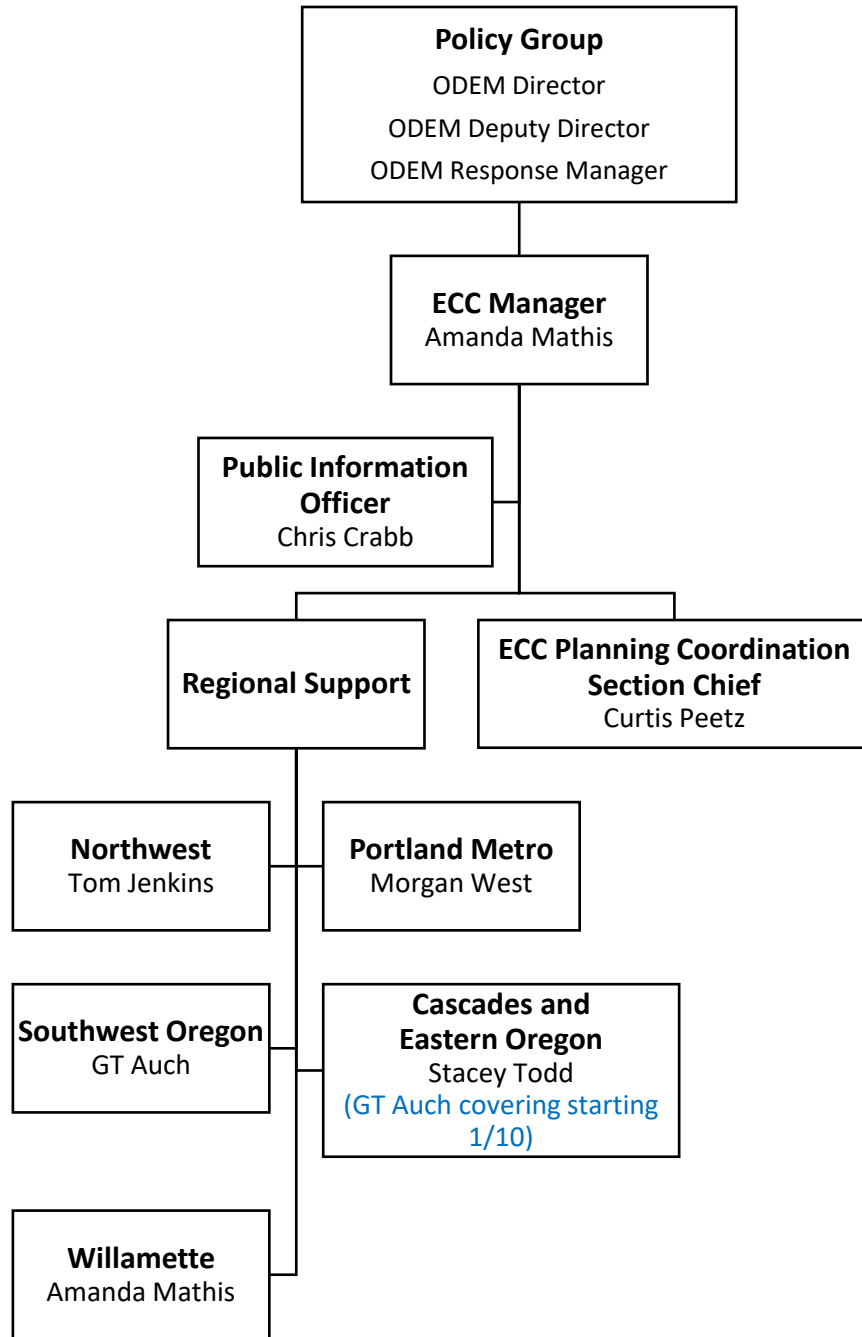
