Dear Charles Ransom:

This is to notify you that the Technology Plan for Woodburn SD has been certified as meeting the full, comprehensive set of planning criteria stipulated by the State of Oregon, FCC Universal Service Fund e-Rate program.

This certification is effective June 30, 2012 to June 30, 2015. It allows you to participate for the duration of the certification in the FCC Universal Service Fund e-Rate program.

This letter is not a notice of plan approval for the Ed-Tech Title IID program and does not supersede any correspondence you receive regarding that program. You will receive a separate notice of your plan status for Ed-Tech. This notice applies to the e-Rate program and criteria ONLY.

If the district makes changes to the proposed technology plan or budget prior to the expiration date of this plan, you will need to submit the revised plan and budget for review by the Oregon Department of Education in order to remain eligible for E-rate funding. This includes any revisions made in order to comply with Ed-Tech program criteria. If you are asked to make revisions to your plan, it does not affect your approval status for e-Rate. Plans that are resubmitted due to Ed-Tech revisions will automatically be reevaluated for e-Rate and a new approval letter generated. In the unlikely event that Ed-Tech revisions bring you out of compliance for e-Rate, you will be contacted immediately.

Changes in federal statute or guidance may also require revisions of planning criteria or the technology plan certification process. Should this occur, the Oregon Department of Education will notify your district regarding any actions that may be required.
