TECP & OUTREACH

Our Therapeutic Early Childhood Program and Outreach Program offer:

- Home Visiting services centered around child and family goals
- Wobbler (Lebanon site only), Toddler and Preschool Classroom services offered twice a week for 3 hours
- Respite Class for children 2-5 years old bi-weekly for 2 ½ hours
- Developmental Assessments (ASQ/ ASQ:SE)
- Access to community resources and referrals

FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM

Family Support and Connections focuses on child abuse prevention by providing one on one parent education, connecting families with local resources, and helping families reach goals that they set.

PEER MENTORSHIP

- A Peer Mentor is a person with lived experience that understands the problems of substance use and/or mental health. A Peer has “been there” and has walked the journey of recovery and wellness. Peers offer valuable relationship and can walk alongside the family to address barriers for a period of time.
- Peer Mentors help parents in recovery from substance use and/or mental health issues and assist parents maintaining sobriety by helping to access meetings, treatment, referrals to agencies and other supports as needed.
