Summer EBT (SEBT)

Summer EBT is a new grocery benefits program to help families buy food for their school-age children during the summer when school is out.

- School-age children participating in SNAP, TANF, OHP, or are in foster care are automatically enrolled
- Children who are not participating in public assistance programs and attend schools with National School Lunch free- or reduced-price meal programs may apply if they meet financial requirements
- Application will be available on **sebt.oregon.gov** starting July 1st



Summer EBT will serve an estimated 350,000 Oregon children with a total annual issuance of over \$42 million in food benefits.

Summer EBT (SEBT)

- Provides \$120 for each eligible child
- School-age children participating in SNAP, TANF, OHP, or are in foster care will receive benefits June 28, 2024
 - Benefits are issued in one payment on an Oregon EBT card
- Students eligible by application will receive a decision notice, and benefits if eligible, within 30 days of applying
 - Benefits are issued in one payment to a new EBT card mailed to the household
- After 122 days from issuance, any unused SEBT Benefits will expire.



Summer EBT will serve an estimated 350,000 Oregon children with a total annual issuance of over \$42 million in food benefits.


Summer EBT Application Sources

Starting July 1st, 2024, Summer EBT Applications will be accessible to applicants through the Summer EBT Online Applicant Portal, mail, and email. Each application will have a unique Application ID.



Summer EBT Online Applicant Portal

- Families can apply for benefits through the Summer EBT Online Applicant Portal, accessible from the Oregon Summer EBT site.
- The Summer EBT Online Applicant Portal will have a respective paper application for downloading and printing.



Summer EBT Application Sources

- Applicants can alternatively submit Summer EBT paper applications in the mail to designated Summer EBT PO boxes.
- Applicants are also able to submit fillable PDF applications using email to the Summer EBT secure inbox.

Key messages and resources for Summer EBT participants

Starting in July 2024, families can:

- Check their current Oregon EBT card account to see if Summer EBT benefits were added.
- Look for a letter in the mail that confirms their child's eligibility.
- If they don't get Summer EBT by mid-July and think their child is eligible, they may need to apply. Contact the Call Center or go to sebt.oregon.gov for help.
- Families can apply until September 2.

Grocery money for kids this summer

Learn how a new program can help cover the cost of food during summer break

Summer EBT is a new food benefit program to help families buy groceries for their school-aged children each summer. If you qualify, you will get **\$120 for each eligible child** to spend on food. Families use an Oregon EBT card to buy groceries.

School-age children are eligible if:

- Your family receives SNAP, TANF or Medicaid (OHP), or
- Your child goes to a school with the National School Lunch (NSLP) or School Breakfast Program (SBP), and your family's income meets the requirements.

Most families will automatically get Summer EBT. Some families may need to apply.

- If your family already receives SNAP, TANF or OHP, your child will be automatically signed up. You don't need to do anything. Children in foster care also are signed up automatically.
- If your child is not automatically signed up and may be eligible, you'll need to apply.

Starting in July 2024, families can:

- Check your current Oregon EBT card account to see if Summer EBT benefits were added.
- Look for a letter in the mail that confirms your child's eligibility.
- If you don't get Summer EBT by mid-July and think your child is eligible, you may need to apply. Contact the Call Center or go to sebt.oregon.gov for help. You can apply until September 2.
