Early Adopter Closed

ArcGIS Pro Technical Preview 4 (build 828) was the last release to ArcGIS Early Adopter sites. Internal staff can install a self-extracting exe from [\\metro\released\ArcGIS Pro\TP4-828](#).

Beta Program

The ArcGIS Pro beta program is scheduled to begin the end of April. All existing Early Adopter sites, Distributors, Partners and ArcGIS for Desktop customers current on maintenance will be invited to participate in the beta program. We plan to have new beta releases every 3-4 weeks leading up to a Prerelease in Q3. Access to Beta resources and the software will require users to be a user in an ArcGIS Online organization.

ArcGIS 10.2 - 10.2.2 for Server OpenSSL (Heartbleed) Patch

The ArcGIS 10.2 - 10.2.2 for Server OpenSSL (Heartbleed) Patch is now live on the support site. Users using ArcGIS for Server on Linux at versions 10.2, 10.2.1, and 10.2.2 must install this patch. This patch addresses an exploitable vulnerability caused by an OpenSSL defect commonly called Heartbleed.

ArcGIS Server uses a library called OpenSSL that has a serious security vulnerability (CVE-2014-160). The OpenSSL vulnerability is exploitable in ArcGIS for Server on Linux, but not on Windows. When exploited, the memory in the print service and publishing services may be accessed - this may reveal to an attacker information such as the file locations, machine names, and the name of the user running ArcGIS Server. It cannot be used to reveal private keys. For a full discussion of the vulnerability in ArcGIS for Server please visit Knowledge Base - Technical Article [42407](#). It deals specifically with the issues listed below-

Issues Addressed with this patch

- NIM100876 - The print service and publishing service in ArcGIS Server on Linux are vulnerable to an OpenSSL defect that reveals the in-memory contents of the print service and publishing tools.
Description: This issue allows an attacker to reveal in-memory contents of the print and

publishing service, including deployment details for ArcGIS Server on Linux including installation location, process owner, and other details.

- NIM100949 - Update ArcGIS Server so it will not report a "false positive" when tested for OpenSSL Vulnerability CVE-2014-0160 (Heartbleed).

OpenSSL Vulnerability CVE-2014-0160 (Heartbleed)

A Knowledge Base article on the vulnerability in the OpenSSL code (dubbed by the media as the "Heartbleed" security vulnerability) has been published.

What is new in ArcGIS Server 10.2.2? (includes Portal for ArcGIS and GeoEvent Processor extensions)

ArcGIS 10.2.2 is a maintenance release. The list of ArcGIS (Desktop, Engine, Server) issues addressed in 10.2.2 are available at <http://support.esri.com/en/downloads/patches-servicepacks/view/productid/66/metaid/2069>

The next planned update to ArcGIS Server with new features is 10.3.

Highlights of 10.2.2 for ArcGIS Server users and other release notes:

- ArcGIS Server:
 - Substantial performance improvements made to the IIS Web Adaptor. Optimizations are most notable for short transaction requests such as map tile retrieval for non-secured and secured (GIS tier authentication) services.
 - Listing of services in the Services Directory and ArcGIS Server Manager has also been dramatically improved, particularly in multi-machine ArcGIS Server sites with hundreds of services.
 - Changing the http protocol settings (http only versus https only or http/https) of ArcGIS Server does no longer require updating the configuration of the ArcGIS Web Adaptor. Security changes in http protocol in the GIS Server will be recognized by the Web Adaptor automatically after 60 seconds.
 - Updated versions of the Tomcat and JRE versions to accommodate third party security vulnerabilities in this third party components.
- Portal for ArcGIS:
 - Updated versions of the Tomcat and JRE versions to accommodate third party security vulnerabilities in this third party components.
 - Added support for PKI when using LDAP authentication (Java Web Adaptor)
 - Numerous fixes to support PKI authentication in Portal for ArcGIS and clients (Operations Dashboard, Esri Maps for Office)
 - The Portal Web Site has not been updated in this release. This means that Application Templates and other Portal Web Site enhancements included with the December and March releases of ArcGIS Online will not take effect in Portal for ArcGIS. - Support for Offline Workflows with Collector for ArcGIS
 - The latest version of Collector for ArcGIS supports offline workflows against your own ArcGIS Server services. This includes offline workflows with data from your own enterprise geodatabases and cached map services. ArcGIS 10.1 SP1 QIP for Desktop Print Dialog Hang Patch

This patch addresses issues some users experienced with certain printers, drivers, and user profiles, wherein the first print of the day from ArcMap would cause the application to stop responding.

Issue addressed with this patch

NIM098209 - After initially starting ArcMap, sending the first print job of the day will hang the program. After restarting ArcMap, subsequent print jobs execute successfully.

ArcGIS 10.1 SP1 for (Desktop, Engine, Server) Quality Improvement Patch

If you have a Microsoft SQL Server, PostgreSQL or IBM DB2 or Informix geodatabase and you have already downloaded and installed this patch, you can ignore this message as this issue only affects Oracle geodatabases.

On March 21st, an issue in ArcGIS 10.2.1 was discovered that can affect customers using an Oracle geodatabase. (See KB article [42335](http://support.esri.com/en/knowledgebase/techarticles/detail/42335))

This issue is also in the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP). We temporarily removed the 10.1 SP1 QIP while we determined how to fix the issue. The fix for the issue described in KB article 42335 will be available shortly as a general patch, to be applied on top of the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP). If you have an Oracle geodatabase and have downloaded the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP), but have not yet installed it, please wait for the new general

patch that will address this issue. If you have already downloaded and installed the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP) and believe that you are encountering the issue in KB article 42335, please notify Esri technical support. There is no need to uninstall the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP) if you have already installed it.

Note: The 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP) is now available again for download, as the fix for the issue described in KB article [42335](#) is to be applied on top of the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP) and did not require the 10.1 SP1 Quality Improvement Patch (QIP) to be re-built.

ArcGIS 9.3.1 News

ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP (Desktop, Engine, Server) Utilities and Telecom Patch

ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP (Desktop, Engine, Server) Utilities and Telecom Patch is available for download. This patch supersedes the [ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP \(Desktop, Engine, Server\) Geodatabase Patch](#) and the [ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP \(Desktop, Engine, Server\) Geometric Network Patch](#). The ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP (Desktop, Engine, Server) Utilities and Telecom Patch can be installed over top of the existing patches.

The ArcGIS 9.3.1 SP2 QIP (Desktop, Engine, Server) Utilities and Telecom Patch includes bug fixes focused on utility and telecom facilities management workflows. Areas addressed by the patch include the geometric network, reconcile/conflict management and replication. Esri Maps for Office 2.1.3

Esri Maps for Office v2.1.3 released April 4, 2014 with support for 32-bit and 64-bit Microsoft Office 2010 and 2013 in 22 languages. This release of Esri Maps for Office 2.1.3 offers improvements and fixes in several areas such as:
