#### **ArcGIS 10.3 Prerelease – General Information**

Release Date: October 7, 2014

### Availability: Download Only on My Esri - No Tangible Media Available

Existing ArcGIS Pro Beta users will receive an update notification for Prerelease through their software just like previous Beta releases

#### Time Out: January 7, 2015

- ArcGIS 10.3 Prerelease downloads time out January 7, 2015
  - ArcGIS 10.3 Prerelease downloads will be removed from My Esri 2 weeks prior to final release

#### What's Included in ArcGIS 10.3 Prerelease

- ArcGIS Desktop
  - ➤ All extensions included with the exception of Business Analyst, Roads and Highways and Full Motion Video
- ArcGIS Server
  - ➤ All extensions included with the exception of Business Analyst, Roads and Highways and ArcGIS for Inspire
- ArcGIS Pro
  - ➤ The following extensions will be included: Network Analyst, 3D Analyst, Data Reviewer, Geostatistical Analyst, Workflow Manager and Spatial Analyst
- ArcGIS Engine
- Esri Developer Network (EDN)
- Amazon Machine Image (AMIs)

### **ArcGIS 10.3 Prerelease Licensing**

- ArcGIS Desktop and Server
  - > Prelease will use licenses from the customer's production license pool
    - Temporary authorization numbers will be available on a request basis for any customer that cannot use production licenses to evaluate prerelease

# **ArcGIS Pro Prerelease – Licensing**

#### ArcGIS Pro

- ArcGIS Pro will be issued based on the customers' actual Desktop licenses current in maintenance
  - ArcGIS Pro Beta 5 allowed access to Desktop Advanced and all extensions
  - ArcGIS Pro licenses assigned at Beta 5 that do not match the final entitlements will need to be reassigned before using ArcGIS 10.3 Pro Prerelease

# **ArcGIS Pro Prerelease – Licensing - Continued**

- Enterprise License Agreements (ELAs)
  - Entitlements are based on the number of Desktop licenses currently activated
    - A report will be provided with quantity of ArcGIS Pro entitlements added to each ELA customer

# **ArcGIS for Portal 10.3 Prerelease Licensing**

- Portal for ArcGIS is Licensed by Named User
- Named Users will be Issued as a Server Entitlement at 10.3 Prerelease
  - Portal for ArcGIS can be licensed for use with ArcGIS for Server Advanced or Standard (Enterprise or Workgroup)
- Named Users for ArcGIS for Portal will not be available to EDN Subscriptions
