Framework – update

- Metadata standards review period is complete. Comments were received from 3-5 individuals (some were anonymous and indistinguishable). The comments appear to mostly minor, although some clarifications on the date and phone number formats were specified to align with FGDC standards. I have skimmed the comments but haven't started incorporating them yet. I anticipate collating these for the Metadata work group in about a week and setting up a meeting with the WG. Process says that they will be posted for another review period.

- A Power Lines work group is getting started to address gaps in power lines datasets that are publicly available. Micah Babinski, a contractor with BLM, is leading this effort under the Utilities FIT. His email is mbabinski@blm.gov. A lively email conversation has been taking place with respect to transmission lines and their categorization as a secure dataset classified as PCII in the 2015 distribution of HSIP Gold as well as concerns over redundant efforts.
- Other things on the horizon with Framework include:
 - FITs are categorizing data elements according to the new prioritization strategy (in progress)
 - Funding selection rubric will be changed to include the new strategy (not started)
 - Late-Feb/Early March release of RFP for Framework funding
 - Spring Framework Symposium to be held on the west side of the Cascades. Location & date TBD. Will work around GIS In Action somehow.
 - Imagery Contract has made it through Stage Gate 2. Cy has more information on when the RFP will go out.

- Committee just forming.

- Project portfolio tool too complex for current requirements
- Google Docs and Gov space discussed as collaboration options
- Spatial Data Library expansion
- NOAA use of collaborative map-based project sharing through SeaSketch.org described
