1. Select your proposals¹

2. Carefully read your selected proposals
3. Prepare brief comments about each of your selected proposals:
 - a. Impression of the proposal relative to the
 - i. Rubric criteria
 - ii. other proposals
 - iii. your role in the reviewing process (i.e., your expertise)
 - b. Overall impression of the project. In other words, what are the proposals' strengths and weaknesses in the topical areas?

Tips: It may be useful to review the [RFP](#) (pg. 6-8)², the rubric(s) criteria, and your responses as you prepare your comments. Another approach is to use the following consideration areas taken from the RFP and rubrics to guide your thinking:

1. GPL
 - a. Technical soundness
 - b. Enterprise orientation
2. FIT
 - a. Data need, maintenance and access / Need, maintenance and access
 - b. Data integration / Integration
 - c. Other considerations
 - i. Alignment to NSDI and FIT
 - ii. Existing/matching funds
 - iii. Standards/common operating procedures
 - iv. [General projects] acceleration of Framework completion
3. PAC
 - a. Enterprise orientation
 - b. Funding and cost
 - c. Other considerations
 - i. Conforms to OAR and ORS
 - ii. Will benefit Oregonians, particularly for service provisioning
 - iii. Accelerates progress towards Governor's goals
