7. Situation Summary

Twenty-eight fires currently are burning in Oregon, with an estimated total of 195,909 acres burned. The National Weather Service issued a Red Flag Warning for wind and low relative humidity from 11 a.m. Friday to 11 p.m. PDT Saturday.

Affected areas in Oregon: Fire Weather Zone 602 North Oregon Coast Range, Fire Weather Zone 603 East Slopes of the Central Oregon Coast Range and Fire Weather Zone 604 Willamette Valley.

Winds: Northeast 10 to 20 mph with gusts up to 30 mph. East wind of 15 to 25 mph with gusts to 40 mph can be expected near the west end of the Columbia River Gorge and Oregon Coast Range ridges. Relative humidity may be as low as 15%.

Impacts: Conditions may be favorable for rapid fire spread that may threaten life and property. A combination of the above conditions can contribute to extreme fire behavior.

Due to the forecast weather, Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, Consumer Power Inc., Lane Electric, and Eugene Water and Electric Board are anticipating executing public safety power shutoffs (PSPS) for approximately 59,000 customers (electrical meters) within Benton, Clackamas, Douglas, Hood River, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Polk, Multnomah, Tillamook, Washington and Yamhill Counties. PSPS were initiated September 9. As of 1400, 32,234 customers are without power due to PSPS preventive outages and other causes.
