7. Situation Summary

On September 8, 2022, the Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM) Emergency Coordination Center (ECC) activated to monitor wildfires and public safety power shutoffs, and facilitate information sharing and resource coordination. Evacuation orders are in place for six wildfires. Multiple state agencies and emergency management partners are supporting firefighting and response needs. Resources from two states are providing support through the Emergency Management Assistance Compact (EMAC).

Twenty-three fires currently are burning in Oregon, with an estimated total of 286,381 acres burned.

Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, Lane Electric, and Eugene Water and Electric Board executed public safety power shutoffs (PSPS) for approximately 59,000 customers (electrical meters) within Benton, Clackamas, Douglas, Hood River, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Polk, Multnomah, Tillamook, Washington and Yamhill Counties. PSPS were initiated September 9. As of 1400, on Sept. 11, 12,622 customers are without power due to PSPS preventive outages and other causes.

Declarations:

- On Aug. 27, Governor Brown invoked the Emergency Conflagration Act for the Rum Creek Fire (EO 22-16).
- On Aug. 28, Governor Brown Proclaimed a State of Emergency due to Imminent Wildfire Threat Statewide (EO 22-17).
- On Sept. 3, Governor Brown invoked the Emergency Conflagration Act for the Double Creek Fire (EO 22-18).
- On Sept. 6, Governor Brown invoked the Emergency Conflagration Act for the Sturgill Fire (EO 22-19).
- On Sept. 9, Governor Brown invoked the Emergency Conflagration Act for the Cedar Creek Fire (EO 22-20).

- On Sept. 10, FEMA Region X approved a Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) for the Milo McIver Fire burning in Clackamas County.

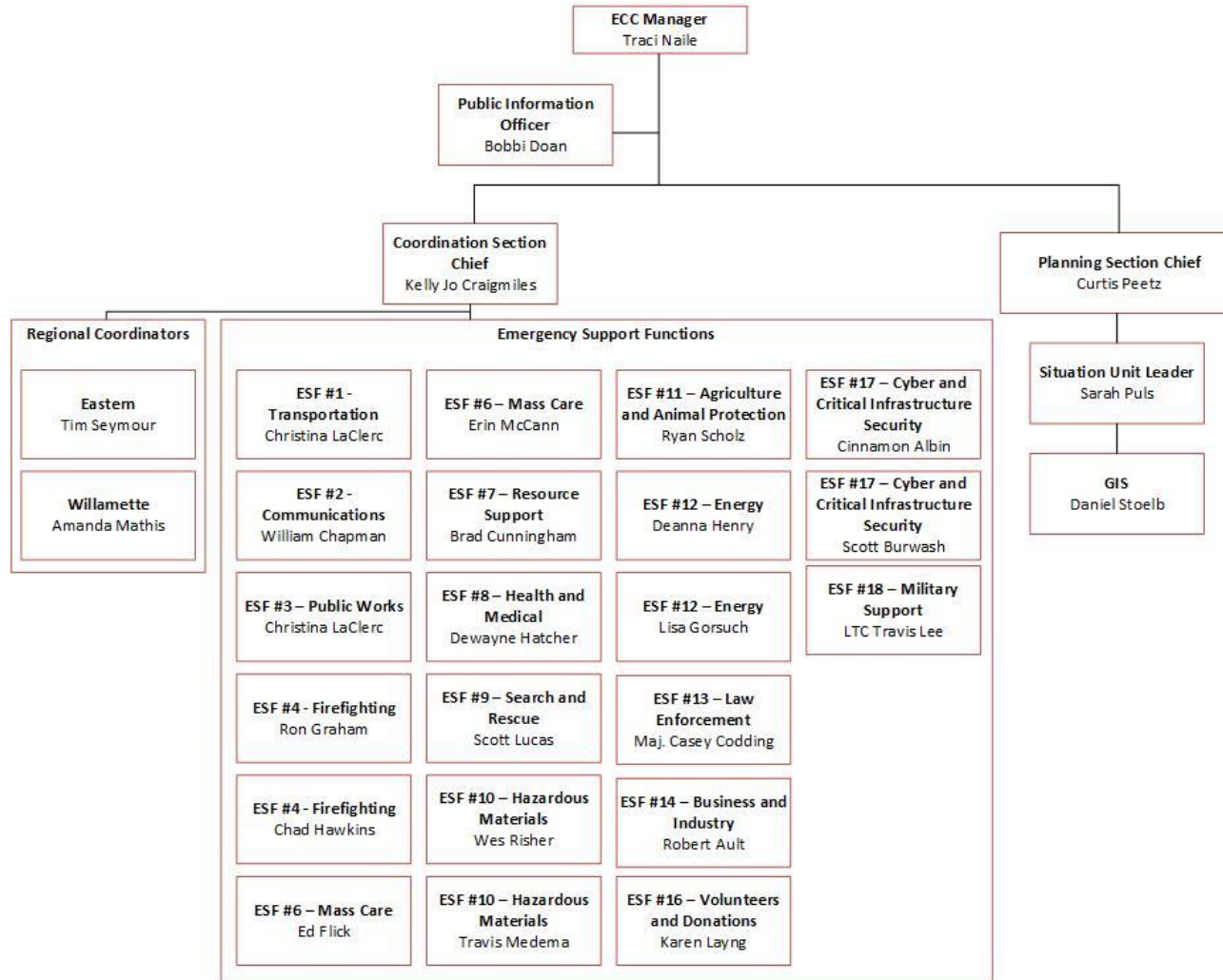
