


2024 Imagery Collection

- ► GIO leading procurement effort.
- Simultaneously working on two paths:
 - > special procurement for previous imagery vendor (legal review)
 - open procurement for new vendor (likely path)
- ▶ Very active, high priority project; no guarantee of a 2024 product as both paths forward have failure potential.



Imagery Portfolio

- Set of products for consistent acquisition
- Serve multiple use cases for highest number of funding partners
- ► Reasonable cost
- Optional buy-ups & derivative products





Imagery Portfolio

- ► Next Step Survey to County Assessors
- ▶ Other Activities To Be Completed:
 - > Determine other stakeholder groups and perform outreach
 - Summarize results of all inputs into a draft portfolio
 - Vet draft portfolio with stakeholder groups and make edits that have consensus (public comment period)
 - Finalize portfolio
 - Need draft by April to support procurement for Long-Term Funding Strategy

- High-priority project beginning now (January 2024)
- Set up State-owned AWS bucket and servers for imagery hosting.
- Migrate hosted services from vendor to State.
- ► Planned completion date: June 30, 2024
