Old Town Clinic Outreach Call Center Pilot Program Volunteer

Central City Concern currently has an opportunity for volunteers who wish to play an integral part in an exciting pilot project at Old Town Clinic (OTC). Volunteers will staff a patient outreach call center, contacting OTC patients to spread awareness and encourage participation in OTC's disease management (diabetes, tobacco use, etc.) groups. People looking to gain experience in medicine or social service are encouraged to apply.

Volunteers will receive electronic medical record (EMR) training, gain experience with outreach to at-risk populations, work toward the possibility of further opportunities at the Clinic, and receive a letter of recommendation upon completion of volunteering, if desired.

Preferred availability is one evening (5:00pm to 8:00pm) per week – tentatively set for Tuesdays – over the course of at least four to six months.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- 8. Weekly time commitment required
