The Lane County Public Health Prevention team works at promoting and coordinating effective community-based prevention strategies toward creating healthier communities.

This new position is funded by two grants and will focus on mental health promotion as well as healthy communities. This position includes collaborative work with various community partners to implement policy changes, providing expertise in mental health promotion, worksite wellness, and supporting implementation of the county's Healthy Communities and Mental Health Promotion work plans.

This position will join the expanded prevention program within Public Health. This is an exciting opportunity as we move forward in our understanding of mental health promotion, reducing Adverse Childhood Experiences, and increasing overall well-being. The professional in this position will address population-based health issues, help develop, implement, and evaluate public health interventions, programs, and policies that promote and protect the public's health; work with community partners and members by fostering collaboration, establishing and maintaining partnerships.

Requirements for this position include:

Valid Oregon's Driver's License is required at time of hire.

Education:

Master of Public Health (MPH) degree or Master of Science degree in Public Health (MSPH) or a Master degree with major course work in public health from an accredited college or university. If applicant does not have a MPH, a Certified Prevention Specialist (CPS) must be obtained within two years of hire.

Experience:

Three years of increasingly responsible experience in Public Health program planning, implementation and evaluation.

*An equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above.
