This is a grant funded position that works in the Prevention section of Lane County Public Health and will focus on reducing adolescent drug and alcohol use and misuse in Eugene, Springfield, and Florence.

This position will serve as the Drug Free Communities grant project coordinator whose duties include collaborative work with various community partners to implement policy changes, provide expertise in substance abuse prevention information and evidence based substance abuse prevention programming. This position will work closely with community coalitions in the Metro Area as well as in the Siuslaw Area.

One of the essential functions of these positions is to travel within Lane County, as well as the state to complete scheduled meetings and appointments.

The Lane County Public Health Prevention team works at promoting and coordinating effective community-based prevention strategies toward creating healthier communities

### **Requirements for this position:**

- CPS (Certified Prevention Specialist) within two (2) years of hire.

### **Training:**

Masters degree in Public Health (MPH); Masters of Science degree in Public Health (MSPH); or a Masters degree with major course work in Public Health from an accredited college or university.

### **Experience:**

Three years of increasingly responsible experience in Public Health program planning, implementation and evaluation.
