

Pacific University in Forest Grove, OR is seeking public health professionals with teaching experience to offer our introductory public health survey course for the undergraduate public health program during the 2018 fall and 2019 spring semesters.

The terms run from August 27 – December 12, 2018 and from January 28 – May 14, 2019. The course is scheduled to meet from 7:55-9:30am on Tuesday and Thursday during the fall term and from 2:45-4:20pm on Tuesday and Thursday during the spring term. (Some schedule flexibility is possible for the spring term as needed.) Classes take place on the Forest Grove campus.

Pacific is a residential liberal arts college that emphasizes small class sizes and student-centered learning. The Public Health program is an interdisciplinary major grounded in the Social Sciences.
