This supervisor position is responsible for effective and efficient management of the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) and is a member of the leadership team of Lane County Public Health.

The WIC supervisor manages the day-to-day activities of this highly regulated and complex program, which include a staff of 17 and a monthly caseload of over 7,400; oversees the program budget and reporting; complies with appropriate state and federal statutes governing program operation; participates in local planning/task force committees; implements joint projects; participates in Public Health initiatives and contributes to strategic planning and implementation. Performs other pertinent duties as assigned.

- Previous experience in a local WIC Program
- Master's degree in Public Health, Nutrition Sciences, Public Administration or a related field
