RULE SUMMARY

These rules create requirements for the Oregon Health Authority to provide resources and support for improving the cultural competence of regulated health care professionals in Oregon and to report to the Oregon State Legislature about the level of participation in cultural competence education among regulated health-care professionals. The rules require the Authority to establish an advisory committee to establish criteria for cultural competence continuing education and recommend continuing education opportunities for adoption. The rules require that the Authority collaborate with designated boards to create a documentation structure and model rules for implementation of continuing education documentation requirements.

The Agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing negative economic impact of the rule on business.
