Oregon's State Advisory Committee on Historic Preservation meets in Springfield

Oregon's State Advisory Committee on Historic Preservation (SACHP) will consider nominations to the National Register of Historic Places in a one-day meeting on February 18th at the Springfield City Hall Library Meeting Room, 225 5th St., Springfield, beginning at 1:00pm.

The Committee will review proposed nominations for individual properties in the communities of Rogue River, Klamath Falls, Eugene, and Springfield. Nominations recommended by the SACHP go to the National Park Service, which maintains the Register under the authority of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. Members of the committee hold credentials in many historic preservation-related fields.
