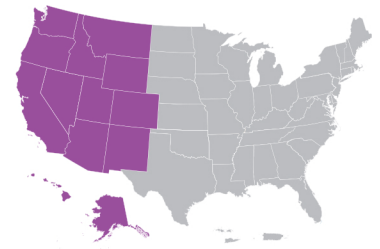

## Technical Assistance to Improve HIV Prevention and Care for Transgender Persons

The Capacity Building Assistance Provider Network (CPN) has launched new services for community-based organizations (CBOs) to complement and extend the reach of HIV prevention and care efforts for transgender people. CBOs are uniquely positioned for this important work, and technical assistance (TA) is now available to support CBOs in addressing social determinants of health and collaborating with their clinical and health department partners to deliver services to transgender people.
