# Oregon 2014 Teen Video Challenge Submission Guidelines

## Eligibility

The 2014 Teen Video Challenge for Oregon is open only to legal U.S. residents who are residents of Oregon aged 13 -18. Participants are ineligible if directly related to the panel of judges for the contest. By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Contest Rules. Each participant or group may submit one video per entry. Each entry must include signed model release form(s). All submissions must be received by **February 14**. Late entries will not be accepted. A DVD of the video will be requested from the winner.

## Terms and Conditions

All audio and artwork must be created by the entrant or be in the public domain, and must be specified as such on the entry form. CSLP (and all CSLP member affiliates) have permission to use the "2014 Teen Video Challenge" submissions, including all work created and all intellectual property embodied therein, as per the Contest Release form.

## Video Criteria for Acceptance

All videos must:

- Be 30 to 90 seconds long.
- Promote the idea of using public libraries and reading.
- Include your interpretation of the 2014 CSLP teen slogan "Spark a Reaction."
- Be designed for use at any library.
- Be appropriate for viewing by audiences of all ages.

## Video Criteria for Judging

- Creativity
- Message clarity and relevance
- Motivation and inspiration
- Overall impact

## How to Enter

2. **Create** your video.
3. **Title** your video with: "2014 TVC - OR - *Unique Name*" Please choose a unique name that does not include your real name.
4. **Upload** your video to **YouTube.com or Vimeo.com**
5. **Fill out and sign** your completed Entry Form & Model Release form(s) and:
6. **Mail** completed forms by **February 14** to "2014 TVC" c/o CSLP Liaison / North Bend Public Library / 1800 Sherman Ave / North Bend, OR 97459 **OR** scan the form or complete electronically and send to [oyancslp@gmail.com](mailto:oyancslp@gmail.com). **Late entries will not be considered.**
7. **Vote** by **March 7** by "Liking" your favorite videos in the 2014 Playlist at [www.youtube.com/OregonTVC](http://www.youtube.com/OregonTVC).

Entries will be posted in this year's Playlist on the Oregon TVC channel on YouTube ([www.youtube.com/OregonTVC](http://www.youtube.com/OregonTVC)). Your votes, and the TVC Video Criteria, will determine the Oregon Teen Video Challenge winner!

## Winners and Prizes

CSLP will review all state winners during March 2014. In the spring of 2014, CSLP will award each CSLP approved State Teen Video Challenge Winner \$275. Their Local Public Library will receive prizes worth \$125 from CSLP and Upstart.
