

WAS YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID LOST OR DESTROYED IN A WILDFIRE?

If your driver's license, Oregon ID, vehicle title, or registration was lost to a natural disaster, the information below may help you replace your documents.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

Replacement of a driver's license is \$26.00 (\$56.00 for Real ID)

Replacement of an ID is \$39.50 (\$65.50 for Real ID)

**Provide an updated address when you request a replacement.*

PERMANENT RESIDENT CARD
