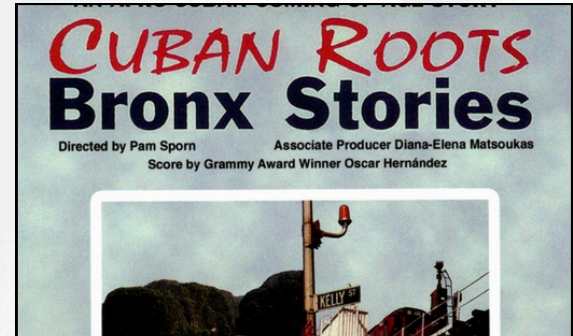

Sin lugar: How intragroup microaggressions impact Afro-Latina Graduate Students

**Dr. Angel Jones, Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Coordinator  
University of Maryland's College of Information**

Dr. Angel Jones is an educator, activist, and critical race scholar who uses creative methods such as hip-hop and poetry to center the voices and experiences of the Black community. Her research explores the impact of racism on mental health with a focus on microaggressions and Racial Battle Fatigue. Dr. Jones is also a public scholar who uses social media as an educational tool to increase access to academic scholarship. She is the author of *Street Scholar: Using Public Scholarship to Educate, Advocate, and Liberate* which is an unapologetic call-to-action that challenges academia to thoughtfully and intentionally engage in public scholarship. **2-3:15 PM EST / 11AM-12:15 PM PST**
