### **Call for Presenters**

Federal legislation requires each State to create citizen review panels (CRPs) comprised of citizen volunteers who are authorized by law to evaluate the extent to which the agencies are effectively discharging their child protection responsibilities. Panels examine the policies, procedures and practices; review cases; hold public hearings; and report annually on efforts to ensure that the State is in compliance with child protection requirements. The panels make recommendations for system and practice improvement.

Oregon is hosting the National CRP Conference in 2015. The National Conference Planning Committee is accepting proposals for WORKSHOP SESSIONS (75 minutes) to be presented at the 2015 National CRP Conference, May 18-20, 2015, at The Benson Hotel in Portland, Oregon.

The theme of the 2015 National CRP Conference is ***People, Programs & Performance: Piecing Together Successful Citizen Review Panels***. The Conference Planning Committee is seeking proposals for workshops that will actively engage conference participants in dialogue about successful child welfare programs, policies, and practices; child welfare related research and assessment efforts; system reforms; and other lessons learned that foster the development and success of CRPs.
