

RSPs & CAICs WHAT ARE THEY?

RSPs Regional Service Providers provide consultation and training to Oregon's MDTs and CAICs. They are located in child abuse intervention centers, but are not tasked with providing direct services.

CAICs Child Abuse Intervention Centers are direct service providers for medical assessments and other victim services. CAICs are designed to minimize trauma to child abuse victims by coordinating the local community's investigation, assessment, and intervention related to reports of suspected child abuse.

CORE REGIONAL SERVICES

MDTs and CAICs are encouraged to access the following services through their RSP:

CONSULTATION

MDT members (including CAIC staff) can talk with their RSP about individual cases of child abuse, child abuse medical assessments, and related topics to get input, suggestions or opinions.

COMPLEX CASE ASSISTANCE

When a CAIC or MDT consults with their RSP about cases that present unique challenges or complexity, the RSP may offer a medical examination, forensic interview and/or other services if the RSP thinks the service is necessary to evaluate, diagnose or treat the victim.

EDUCATION

RSPs can share documents, webinars, or other resources about detecting, evaluating, diagnosing and treating child abuse.

TRAINING

RSPs teach the **Oregon Child Forensic Interview Training (OCFIT)**. This training is based on the Oregon Interviewing Guidelines. MDTs can also talk with their RSP about providing specialized training on related topics such as interviewing children with disabilities.

MEDICAL ASSESSMENT TRAINING

Medical Assessment Training is conducted by a medical practitioner. It includes training on physical abuse, sexual abuse, and Karly's Law. Medical Assessment Training is largely based on the American Academy of Pediatrics guidelines and other sources developed by the RSPs and approved by the CAMI Fund Coordinator.

PEER REVIEW FOR FORENSIC INTERVIEWS AND MEDICAL ASSESSMENTS

RSPs coordinate reviews of interviews or medical services for educational purposes. Those who conduct child forensic interviews or child abuse medical examinations should participate regularly.

REFERRAL SERVICES

RSPs can refer you to resources (like people, policies, and research) that can help you with your work.

Available services vary somewhat from RSP to RSP. Please contact your RSP directly with questions about these services. To ensure that services meet MDT and RSP needs, MDTs and CAICs are encouraged to contact the CAMI Fund Coordinator if services cannot be provided by the RSP.
