Tuition

NEW PROCESS UPDATE: OCFIT tuition will not be due until after the application status notifications are released.

Once an applicant is conditionally accepted for the training, they will be required to pay the \$350.00 (\$358.18 when paid via card) tuition by **Monday, October 14**, to secure their spot.

OCAS will provide payment instructions with the conditional acceptance notification email.

Application Process

1. Fill out the online application in its entirety and submit it via the above link. All applications must be signed by the applicant.
2. The applicant will be required to forward their acceptance email and/or the approval form link (https://bit.ly/Oct2024ocfit_approval) to their supervisor to approve their participation in OCFIT.
3. The MDT Chair/DA of the applicant's county will receive an email from OCAS requesting approval for the applicant.
