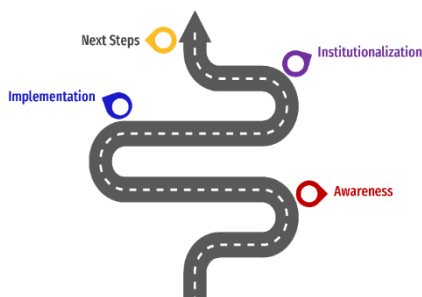


Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Roadmap and Toolkit Academy



Children are impacted on a daily basis by their parents or caregivers substance misuse; often these children are the first impacted and the last ones to be identified and to receive services. To help address this the National Alliance for Drug Endangered Children is providing the Roadmap and Toolkit Academy.

This Academy focuses on how to implement the DEC Roadmap and Toolkit which is a strategy in building a multidisciplinary Drug Endangered Children (DEC) Alliance. This course focuses on three stages: Awareness, Implementation and Institutionalization. The information learned and access to the National Alliance for Drug Endangered Children resource portal will allow your alliance to develop and grow at its own pace. Full attendance and participation is highly recommended.
