IMPORTANT

On September 23, 2010, the OEBB Board approved a change that may affect your decisions about covering certain dependent children on your OEBB medical, dental and/or vision plans!

OEBB previously announced that effective October 1, 2010, federal legislation will require OEBB to extend eligibility for medical coverage to dependent children age 19 through 25 with no residential or financial support requirement, regardless of student or marital status.

The two changes listed below further expand dependent children's coverage and eligibility.

On September 24, 2010, OEBB filed temporary rules to implement the following changes:

- 1) Dependent children ages 19 through 25 who gained eligibility for OEBB medical plans effective October 1, 2010, as a result of federal health care reform legislation will not be subject to the 12-month waiting period if they are enrolled in dental and/or vision coverage for the 2010-11 plan year during this initial enrollment period. If you decided not to cover a dependent child who became eligible due to the federal provisions because of the waiting period for full dental and/or vision coverage, you can request to add the dependent at this time. You must complete and submit an "Overage Dependent Child QSC Change Form" to your Educational Entity requesting this addition by no later than October 29, 2010.
- 2) Dependent children ages 19 through 25 who are eligible for medical coverage through their own employment, or covered under another group medical plan, <u>can</u> also be covered on your OEBB medical plan effective October 1, 2010. If you decided not to cover a dependent child <u>who became eligible for coverage due to the new federal provisions</u> because he or she was eligible for or covered on another group medical plan, you can request to add the dependent at this time. You must complete and submit an "Overage Dependent Child QSC Change Form" to your Educational Entity requesting this addition no later than October 29, 2010.
