Dear OEBB Member,

Enclosed is information about your coverage for the 2010-11 plan year through the Oregon Educators Benefit Board (OEBB).

Please review this information carefully. The benefit statement should accurately reflect the benefits and coverage you selected for yourself, and any eligible dependents if applicable, for the 2010-11 plan year.

- **If the information is not correct**, you must contact your educational entity no later than October 29, 2010. They may assist you in accordance with their policies.
- **If this benefit statement accurately reflects the coverage(s) you want**, please keep it for your records and for future reference.

Most benefits go into effect on October 1, 2010. If the coverage effective date listed on the benefit summary is something other than October 1, 2010, this means you did not change this specific plan during open enrollment and the plan is still in effect from when you originally selected it. Or, if there is no effective date, it means the coverage requires approval by Unum for Spouse/Partner Long Term Care.
