Annual notice re: OEBB's Healthy Futures wellness incentive program

Dear OEBB Member:

The attached notice contains information about OEBB's Healthy Futures wellness incentive program, including requirements to earn the incentive, privacy protections, use of medical information, and reasonable accommodation for members with disabilities. To comply with federal regulations, we are sending this notice to all OEBB members, regardless of program participation.

New for 2017-18: No More Spouse/Domestic Partner Requirement

Spouses and domestic partners no longer need to participate to earn the incentive. Only the benefits-eligible employee/retiree/COBRA member needs to participate to earn the incentive for all individuals covered on the OEBB medical plan.

The Healthy Futures incentive program provides an opportunity to lower your medical deductible or copays by completing an online health assessment and taking two healthy actions. The program will help you identify health risks and understand how to take action to reduce or eliminate those risks whenever possible.

If you complete the requirements of the Healthy Futures program within the designated timeframes, effective October 1, 2017, your OEBB medical plan deductible will be reduced \$100/person (up to a \$300 value per family depending on plan selection and number of individuals covered) or, if enrolled in Kaiser Plan 1 (which has no deductible), your copays on certain services will be reduced.
