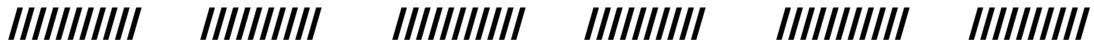

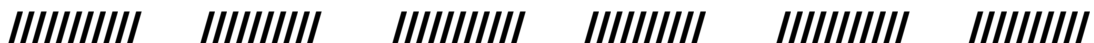


EXECUTIVE SESSION

There are currently 52 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 3 in the contested case process. Of the open cases under investigation, 40 are regarding licensed practice (including 3 applicants) and 12 are regarding unlicensed practice.
