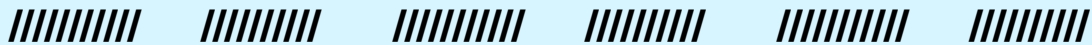

- 1) Licensure

46 new applications have been received and 23 licenses have been issued in 2012. There are currently 1637 total licensees, including 1270 active, 194 semi-active, 166 inactive, 5 on probation and 2 suspended.
