**RULE SUMMARY**

The proposed rule change clarifies the amount of continuing education (CE) sufficient to maintain professional competence which is required to reactivate a license from inactive status to active or semi-active status. It also delineates the prorated CE and license fee calculation upon reactivation.

**Need for the Rule(s):** The current rule does not specify the amount of continuing education (CE) sufficient to maintain professional competence which is required to reactivate a license from inactive status to active or semi-active status. The proposed rule corrects this deficiency, and also clarifies the calculation of prorated CE and license fee upon reactivation through the end of the renewal period.
