- 1) Licensure

98 new applications have been received and 51 licenses have been issued in 2012. There are currently 1642 total licensees, including 1270 active, 193 semi-active, 172 inactive, 5 on probation and 2 suspended.

- 2) Consumer Protection

65 complaints have been filed in 2012. There are currently 41 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 3 in the contested case process. Of the open cases under investigation, 27 are regarding licensed practice, 2 are regarding applicants, and 12 are regarding unlicensed practice.
