1) Licensure

17 new applications have been received and 13 licenses have been issued in 2013. There are currently 1656 total licensees, including 1284 active, 196 semi-active, 171 inactive, 3 on probation and 2 suspended.

2) Consumer Protection

11 complaints have been filed in 2013. There are currently 36 open cases under investigation (including the investigation files scheduled for Board consideration), with 3 in the contested case process. Of the open cases under investigation, 22 are regarding licensed practice, 3 are regarding applicants, and 11 are regarding unlicensed practice.
